**NOTICE RE: LACK OF PROSECUTION
and ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE**

Plaintiff Peter Massini (“Massini”) initiated this action against Defendant Wasatch Academy (“Wasatch”) by filing a complaint on September 8, 2021.¹

Wasatch filed a waiver of service on October 19, 2021.² An answer was due on November 15, 2021. No answer has been filed, and there is no activity on the docket since the waiver of service more than six months ago. Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that by no later than Tuesday, May 31, 2022, Massini must file a report stating the status of the case and explaining why this case should not be dismissed for lack of prosecution. The status report must include a statement regarding Massini’s (a) diligence in pursuing his claims against Wasatch since the complaint was filed; (b) intent with regard to continued pursuit of his claims against Wasatch; and (c) plans for moving this case to disposition.


